Except for the invited lectures and an international cyber symposium, all presentations are delivered in Japanese, although the slides for oral sessions, not for poster sessions, are shown in English. A chat tool, Slack, is available to registrants for administrative communication, floor discussion, and participant social networking. Since we use an English-Japanese AI simultaneous interpretation app in Slack, we expect registrants to join us for communication. We are planning to have an online banquet (general and as small groups) using the Zoom Meeting system. After six months of selfrestraint, we expect to have virtual but close communication with each other through images and sounds in the Zoom.
